Introduction

Payne, established in 2005 from the merger of PP Payne, Morane and Laminex, is a leading provider of coated film; tear tape and security products worldwide.

Payne operates from 11 sites in eight countries worldwide and employs over 390 people. Within these facilities, Payne operates its most state-of-the-art press (The Gravure) in Nottingham, UK.

The many beneficial factors that an NIFL resin system can provide initially secured the works. And these were then carried out expertly to ensure **100% satisfaction was achieved.**

Helping the Environment

Firstly, the Nottingham site of Payne Worldwide has been awarded ISO1 4001 for its conscientious approach to its environmental obligations. It was explained that an **expertly specified and applied** resin system from NIFL acts as a seal on the porous concrete sub floor, preventing chemicals from passing through. This stops harmful chemical agents damaging the ground beneath.

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Health and Safety Requirements

Secondly, Nottingham Flooring demonstrated its ability to **comply with the most stringent health and safety regulations**. To this end, NIFL provided demarcation lines, forklift to forklift aisles, pedestrian line markings and hatching for fire exits covering 500m² and 500lin m. Applied using high build floor coating, Payne could feel assured their needs were taken care of for the long term.

An Attractive Floor Design

From an aesthetic point of view, NIFL also convinced Payne worldwide of the benefits a **vivid underfoot design** could provide for their company. Using RAL colours to match their corporate identity, NIFL provided 2,500 m² of blue and grey high build floor coating to follow on from their image; helping to impress all those that visited the site.



Battling Against the Clock

Time was also another large factor in the decision to use a seamless resin system from NIFL. Payne Worldwide was reluctant to disrupt their hectic schedule of operations, which could prove very costly. However, NIFL assured Payne they were able to work **364 days PA 24 hours/day** in order to get the job done with minimum disruption.

Payne Worldwide set a challenge which meant even working through Boxing Day and New Years Day. To ensure the work schedule ran smoothly, materials were pre-ordered in advance and in surplus quantities, and even CSCS Skills Card holders who would normally head up office operations went to help out on site.
